

Policy Private Golf Carts

Effective: 10/21/2006

- I. Golf Carts are defined as follows:
 - 1) Must be battery/electric powered, (similar to those ordinarily used on a golf course).
 - 2) Must have no more than 3 bench seats.
- II. The following vehicles are expressly excluded:
 - 1) Gasoline powered golf carts/hybrids
 - 3) ATV's or comparable vehicles
 - 4) Farm or utility type vehicles
- III. Property owners and their personal guests have the privilege of using golf carts on DeBordieu Colony roads provided golf cart owners and operators abide by S.C. State laws and DeBordieu Rules and Regulations.
 - 1) Proof of insurance for the State and DeBordieu Colony.
 - 2) Operation is limited to daylight hours only.
 - 3) OPERATORS MUST HAVE A VALID DRIVERS LICENSE or LEARNERS PERMIT, be at least 15 years of age, and obey all S.C. traffic laws and regulations. 15 year olds with a valid state learners permit must have a licensed adult 21 years of age or older present during operation.
 - 4) Property owners must register their golf cart(s) with DeBordieu Security. Property Owners are required to sign a form agreeing to abide by DeBordieu Colony Rules and Regulations before their decal can be issued.
 - 5) Personal golf carts should never be driven on the golf course or cart paths during normal playing hours to avoid interfering with golf play.
 - 6) Personal golf carts should never be driven on the fairways and rough of the golf course.
